Do you struggle with:

- Difficulty developing and/or maintaining close relationships with other men.
- Feeling inadequate compared to other men.
- Desperately desiring to “fit in” and be part of a group of men (band of brothers).
- Being easily intimidated or persuaded by other men.

This workshop is designed for men who struggle with unwanted same-sex attraction and desire deeper healing of their masculine identity. Through Christ-centered experiential work, teaching, drama, and spiritual renewal activities, men will journey toward a deeper connection with self, God and others.

The setting for this workshop is a secluded, lakeside Christian retreat house and cottage surrounded by wooded fields – a very peaceful and healing environment.

Maximum number of participants will be eight. Participants are highly encouraged to be in an active support group / accountability system and to have at least 30 days sobriety for optimal benefit.

The Participant in Masculine IQ will:

- **Be strengthened in his quest for healthy sexuality and intimate relationships.**
- **Experience deeper connection with self, God, and other men.**
- **Learn about same sex attraction -- its roots and development.**
- **Strengthen his commitment to accountability and deeper honesty with self and others.**
- **Identify and address unresolved relational and spiritual wounds affecting his masculine identity which may contribute to the experience of same-sex attraction.**
- **Develop a plan of action for continued healing and recovery.**
- **Capture a deeper sense of authentic masculinity.**
- **Discover his calling as a "Man of God."**
- **Learn to develop healthier intimacy with both men and women.**
